

PRIMARY UNIFORM

All school uniform items (except shoes and socks) must be purchased from Back to Basics School Wear (52 Cox Avenue, Kingswood or online at <http://www.backtobasicsschoolwear.com.au>) unless otherwise stated.

All uniform items must be clean and in good condition.

K-6 GIRLS (SUMMER AND WINTER)

- Maroon NCS Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) worn with Tartan Shorts or Black Boot Leg Pants
- or
- Tartan Dress
- Knitted Maroon NCS Jumper
- Polar Fleece Maroon NCS Half-zip Jacket
- Zip Up Microfibre NCS Sports Jacket
- Plain black or white socks (no logos or lace - worn below kneecap and at least 10cm above the top of the shoe)
- or
- Black stockings

K-6 BOYS (SUMMER AND WINTER)

- Maroon NCS Polo Shirt (short or long sleeve) worn with Black Shorts or Black Long Pants
- Knitted Maroon NCS Jumper
- Polar Fleece Maroon NCS Half-zip Jacket
- Zip Up Microfibre Sports Jacket
- Plain black or white short (crew length) socks (no logos - worn at least 10cm above the top of the shoe)

Please note: Cargo shorts and trousers were discontinued in 2021. They are not permitted in 2024 and beyond..

YEARS 3-6 UNISEX SPORTS UNIFORM

- Maroon NCS Polo Shirt
- NCS Sports Shorts (loose fitting) or Black Microfibre Track Pants
- Polar Fleece Maroon NCS Half-zip Jacket
- Zip Up Microfibre Sports Jacket
- Plain black or white sport socks (crew or ankle socks permitted)

Exception: Students may be asked to wear long maroon socks with white stripes which can be purchased from the uniform shop (Back to Basics) for sports such as soccer, netball, football and hockey. Worn up to the knee cap.

HATS (WORN ALL YEAR)

- NCS bucket hat or
- NCS sports cap

SHOES

Normal School Days

- Plain black leather school shoes or
- Plain black leather style joggers

Please note: School shoes must cover the entire upper foot. Buckle-style shoes (Mary-Jane shoes) that expose part of the upper foot cannot be worn for safety reasons. Shoes that have mesh uppers or are made of fabric or other lightweight materials cannot be worn on normal school days. Shoes may be lace-up or velcro straps.

Sports Days

- Sturdy sports shoes with supportive sole

Please note: Lightweight canvas shoes and slip-ons cannot be worn. Shoes may be lace-up or velcro straps.

JEWELLERY

- One plain bracelet (less than 10mm width) with a maximum of one dangling object.
- One plain necklace (less than 10mm width) with a maximum of one dangling object, worn under clothing only.
- Two ear piercings on each ear only. Studs must be less than 5mm in diameter. Sleepers must be less than 2mm thick and 15mm in diameter. No hoops, no dangling objects.
- Maximum of one ring per hand, less than 5 mm high
- One watch (not a smart watch i.e must not connect to a phone or the internet)

HAIR & NAILS

- Natural hair colours only
- Hair longer than shoulder length (boys and girls) must be tied back at the back or side and not cover eyes. No man buns, fountains, palm trees or dreadlocks.
- Clips, scrunchies, bands, ribbons and combs must be in school colours (white, maroon or black)
- No fade haircuts e.g. undercuts, shaved sections, mohawks, mullets etc. Hair of different lengths must have a fade between lengths.
- No nail polish
- Nails must be kept short

MAKEUP

- No makeup

EXTREME WEATHER

On extremely cold days students may add the following items only when wearing the long-sleeve polo, half-zip jumper or v-neck sweater AND the microfibre jacket

- Beanie (school colours only)
- Scarf (school colours only)
- Gloves (school colours only)
- Overcoat (school colours only)

VARIATIONS

- If there are medical or personal reasons requiring a permanent variation in the uniform, those variations must be pre-approved by the Head of Primary.
- For short-term variations e.g. school shoes are wet, items are out-of-stock at Back to Basics, students must have a note from a parent indicating the reason for the variation and the anticipated timeframe for the variation.
