

# Secondary English Teacher

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## Role Description:

- English teacher with the ability to teach to HSC
- Permanent full time or part time (0.7FTE)
- Reports to Head of English

## Specific Responsibilities -

- Teach a range of English classes from 7-12, (including the possibility of Extension English classes).
- Teach English from a Christ-centred approach
- Engage with a range of english programs for different ability levels
- Participate enthusiastically in the full spiritual and pastoral life of the school
- Keep abreast of current trends, research and developments in education and areas relevant to the teacher's specific task.

## Specific Requirements -

The successful applicant will:

- Demonstrate an authentic Christian faith with active engagement in a local church or Christian fellowship
- Be understanding and supportive of the Reformed Protestant theological position of the school
- Be passionate in living out their faith in their teaching and relationships
- Have suitable tertiary qualifications from an Australian University (or provide an AEI-NOOSR equivalence) & NESA Accreditation (where required)
- Be thoroughly conversant with the various NSW 7-12 English syllabi
- Demonstrate a capacity to teach all levels of English, including Stage 6
- Be confident in using digital technology (experience in using Google suite, Edumate and Canvas an advantage)

## All teachers at NCS are expected to actively support the Statement of Faith and the Mission and Vision of the School

### Statement of Faith

We believe, uphold and teach the fundamental truths of Christianity contained in Holy Scriptures, including:

- The divine inspiration and infallibility of Holy Scripture as originally given, and its supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.

- The universal sinfulness and guilt of human nature since the Fall, rendering man subject to God's wrath and condemnation.
- The incarnation of Jesus, conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary.
- Redemption from the guilt, penalty and power of sin only through the sacrificial and atoning death of Jesus Christ as our representative and substitute.
- The bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.
- The necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit to make the death of Christ effective in the individual sinner, granting him repentance towards God and faith in Jesus Christ.
- The indwelling of the Holy Spirit in the believer.
- The expectation of the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ

We hold to the traditional biblical view of the intention and purpose of human sexuality, expressed in the context of marriage is between a man and a woman, committed for life, to the exclusion of all others.

It is expected that all staff and association members are able to uphold the Statement of Faith in both their public and private life and are committed to the body of Christian believers through membership of a local church.
