Role Description:

- Committed Christian to work as a Teachers' Aide across K-12

General Responsibilities –

This will involve:

- Work independently with individual and small groups of children
- Provide learning support and assistance for students with disabilities
- Assist students to develop their literacy and numeracy skills
- Assist in producing original material and resourcing new programs
- Assist the class teacher or Learning Support teacher with clerical duties
- Assist in the preparation and application of data required by the government agencies
- Motivate and challenge students in relational, contextual and creative ways
- Attend when required, case conferences, in-services and consultation meetings
- Participate enthusiastically in the full spiritual and pastoral life of the school
- Promote a distinctively Gospel-centred world view in the classroom environment
- Assist with therapy and/or nursing duties if required
- Assist with library duties if required
- Provide special provisions for students in exams (reading questions and writing responses)

- Involvement in school events as required
